Description



While these glue sequences might feel strange at the beginning they help you to format and recognize your markup and make it more readable. That way you will be able to format a WikiApplications that looked like this

Syntax

The `<space>` is a literal whitespace blank. The `~~~<space>` and `*~~<space>` sequences are recognized only at the beginning of a line, whereas the `%~~<space>` escape sequence might appear everywhere. The basic anatomy of writing a tag using the GluePlugin is exemplified by

Plugin Installation Instructions

You do not need to install anything in the browser to use this extension. The following instructions are for the administrator who installs the extension on the server.

Open configure, and open the "Extensions" section. Use "Find More Extensions" to get a list of available extensions. Select "Install".

If you have any problems, or if the extension isn't available in `configure`, then you can still install manually from the command-line. See <http://foswiki.org/Support/ManuallyInstallingExtensions> for more help.

- Set the plugins evaluation order to put the GluePlugin in first position, e.g.

```
$Foswiki::cfg{PluginsOrder} = 'GluePlugin, IfDefinedPlugin, SpreadSheetPlugin';
```





- If the plugin is installed correctly then the following two fruits will appear joined on one line: Apples and Oranges
