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Edit tables with EditTablePlugin

The EditTablePlugin allows you to edit tables using edit fields and drop down boxes. Tables have an [Edit table] button if preceded by an %EDITTABLE{ . . . }% macro. Each column can be a text field, a drop down box, a date field, etc. Multiple tables per topic are editable, but only one at a time can be edited.

Example:

Syntax: %EDITTABLE{ format="| row, -1 | text, 20, init | select, 1, one, two, three, four | radio, 3, :-), :-I, :-I (| label, 0, %SERVERTIME{"\$day \$mon \$year \$hour:\$min"}% | " changerows="on" }%
