WHITE -- start white colored text

- WHITE is one of the shortcut macros predefined in DefaultPreferences. See the section shortcut macros in that topic for a complete list of colors.
- Syntax: %WHITE% white text %ENDCOLOR%
- Expands to: (shown with a gray background here)
-  %<color>% text must end with %ENDCOLOR%. If you want to switch from one color to another one you first need to end the active color with %ENDCOLOR%, e.g. write %RED% some text %ENDCOLOR% %GREEN% more text %ENDCOLOR%.
- Related: ENDCOLOR, DefaultPreferences, StandardColors
