Wiki name

Your name, usually your first and last name connected without a space.

For example, Tim Berners-Lee's WikiName is TimBernersLee.

⚠ Your name is also a potentially valid WikiWord when used within a topic. However the home pages of registered users on this site are stored in the **Main** web. When you sign your username in a topic, prefix it with **Main.** (including the dot). That is, write **Main.WikiGuest** to link to WikiGuest, your personal home page in the Main web. For convenience, your signature is also provided for copying and pasting when editing a topic.

✓ Though rarely used in common practice, you can use the special **%USERSWEB%** macro prefix for user names, for example, **%USERSWEB%.WikiGuest**.
